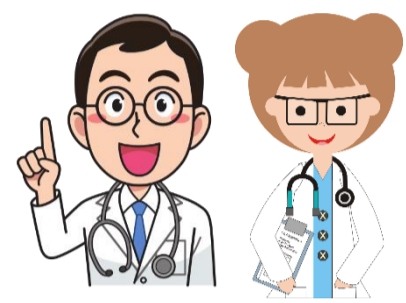

What do we do? *

Paediatricians provide health care for young people, from new-born babies to teenagers. They diagnose, treat, and give advice to their young patients.

Subjects & Route*

To become a paediatrician, you need to complete at least 3 A-Levels, including chemistry and either biology, maths or physics. Once completed you must attend medical school and complete at least 5 years of study. Once you complete medical school you can take a 2-year foundation programme where you will experience different medical specialities. After this you can complete speciality training in paediatrics, this training takes about 8 years to complete.
