This year we will be continuing to reward achievements, Subject Stars, Pupils of the Month, 100% Attendance and Class of the month.

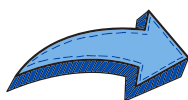
25 YEARS OF MALONE INTEGRATED COLLEGE

What is easyfundraising?

They have a free online platform that raises funds for Malone Integrated College via online shopping. easyfundraising has helped raise over £40 million and has been helping good causes since 2005.



How does easyfundraising work?

They turn everyday online shopping into funds for good causes like us. When you use the easyfundraising website or app to shop online, the retailer sends us a free donation at no additional cost.



Which retailers will donate?

Over 6,000 retailers including Sainsbury's, Booking.com, Sports Direct and eBay. It means that no matter what you're buying online it helps us raise funds.



When will we receive the donations?

Every three months easyfundraising will tot up how much you've all raised and (providing it's over £15) will make a payment direct into our bank account. If the amount raised is less than £15, they carry it forward to their next payment-run.

CREATIVE SCHOOLS PROJECT



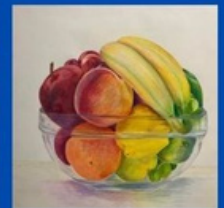
