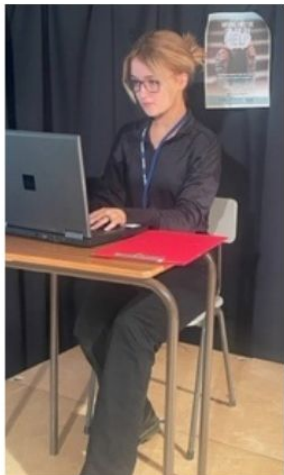
## ECO CLUB TAKE ON FINAGHY
